Day 1[~] KK - SINGAPORE - FUKUOKA ➤

 Assemble at the airport. Take a flight to Osaka.

Day 2~ FUKUOKA - ASO - KUMAMOTO (Lunch/Dinner)

Hotel: Hotel Sunroute Kumamoto/Similar

 Daikanbo: Daikanbo Peak is one of the peaks of Aso northern somma, which is located north east of Uchimaki Onsen (hot spring). At one time, the peak was called Tomigabana (a nose seen from a distance), however the great writer Soho Tokutomi named the peak Daikanbo, due to the request of the Mayor Kojima of Uchimaki town in May of the 11th year of the Taisho Era (1922).



 Kusasenri Field: Kusasenri is located in the perfect location to gaze at the smokey Nakadake Peak of Mt. Aso. Around the big pond that spreads across the center of the vast 1km diameter prairie, cattle freely roam the fields. The landscape changes from one season to another, and this change is another attraction, too.



• Kumamoto Castle: Kumamoto Castle, also known as "Ginnnan Castle", is one of the three best castles of Japan. Famous regional lord, Kato Kiyomasa, began the construction of the castle in 1601 and it was completed seven years later. The premises of this magnificent citadel measures up to be 980,000 square meters (approximately 9 kilometers in circumference at the time of construction) with main towers, 49 turrets, 18 yagura (gates with a turret), and 29 entry gates. Japanese statesman and naval engineer, Katsu Kaishu, once stated; "there are no other castles like this castle", praising its intimidating size and height.



Day 3[~] KUMAMOTO - IBUSUKI - KAGOSHIMA (Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner) Hotel: Remm Kagoshima / Similar

• Ryugu Jinja Shrine: It is located at Nagasakibana, the southernmost point of Satsuma peninsula. Nagasakibana is said to be the birthplace of The Legend of Urashima Taro who saved a turtle, it took him to Ryugu-jo (the Palace of the Dragon) as a token of it's gratitude. Sea turtles come to lay eggs on the beach near this place, and local people love them as the protective god of the sea.



• Sand Bath Experience: Sand Bath Experience is located in Kagoshima Prefecture on the southern island of Kyūshū, the Yamakawa Sunamushi Onsen or Yamakawa Sand Baths (also known as Yamagawa Sunamushi Onsen or Fushimesunamushi Hot Spring), provides an interesting way to enjoy the benefits of the heat and minerals associated with a long hot soak. The onsen water bubbling beneath the coastline (thanks to nearby volcanoes) naturally heats the beach sand above, making way for a most unique bathing experience.



Day 4~ KAGOSHIMA - FUKUOKA (Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner) Hotel: Hotel Monte Hermana / Similar

- Senganen Garden: Senganen Garden, also known as Isoteien, is a Japanese style landscape garden along the coast north of downtown Kagoshima. One of the garden's most striking features is its use of Sakurajima and Kagoshima Bay as borrowed scenery. The garden also includes small ponds, streams, shrines and a bamboo grove.
- Shiroyama Observatory: Shiroyama Observatory with spectacular views over downtown Kagoshima, Kagoshima Bay and Sakurajima. The night view is also nice, particularly if a clear sky and bright moon allow Sakurajima to remain visible.
- Tosu Premium Outlet (Free Time Shopping): Tosu Premium Outlets is the largest outlet mall in Kyushu, with 150 stores. It is located about 30 minutes from Fukuoka Airport.



Day 5~ FUKUOKA (Breakfast) Hotel: Hotel Monte Hermana / Similar
